# Interlibrary Loan

**If we don't have what you are looking for, this may be your answer...**

The interlibrary loan program, administered through the Utah State Library System, provides access to materials not available in the Lewiston Public Library's collection nor in the Northern Cache Library Consortium. Patrons in good standing may request items with the understanding that \$2.00 per item will be charged for return postage.

Overdue fees may be charged at the rate of up to \$1.00 per day per item. Fees will begin to accrue the day after the due date on each item.

Acceptance by the patron of any interlibrary loan item thereby transfers full responsibility to the patron for the item's care and return. Interlibrary loan borrowers will be billed for lost, stolen, or damaged interlibrary loan materials; with the fee determined by the lending library.

# NCLC

**The Northern Cache Library Consortium** (NCLC) is a partnership with the Smithfield, Richmond, Lewiston, and Newton Public Libraries. This gives each of our library patrons access to additional resources. Patrons can search the NCLC catalog and if materials are found in any of the libraries, they can go to that library and check out the material free of charge. Patrons are responsible for pick ups from & returns to the borrowing library. This consortium service was acquired through an LSTA State Grant.
