Mayor's Report

Spring appears to have now officially made an appearance. With it has come some minor flooding and plenty of wet weather. Spring is also a time of renewal; the landscape comes back to life. Many want to clean and beautify their property and to remove the debris from the winter. Lewiston City fully supports and encourages the cleaning and beautification of our town.

In an effort to promote clean-up a solid waste and a green waste dumpster are provided for convenience. These services are provided to Lewiston City by Logan City as part of the waste services contract between Lewiston City, Cache County and Logan City. This is an extra service which is partially financed by an additional fee charged to all customer in Lewiston City for garbage removal. The waste bins are emptied on a schedule set by the Logan City Sanitation crews.

This is a popular service which Lewiston City would like to continue to provide now and into the

future. There are some rules and courtesies which must be followed and observed for this service to continue.

- The bins are to be used only by citizens of Lewiston City
- Only green waste can be placed in the green waste bin
- The bins are not for commercially collected trash
- Tires, batteries, refrigerators and other hazardous materials are not allowed in any of the bins

When a bin is full trash must be held by the collector until there is available space. If the bin is too full Logan City will not collect or empty it. Trash on the ground must be picked up by someone else.

The presence of these waste bins is a great benefit and eliminates long trips to Logan to discard trash. Failure to follow these simple rules of etiquette can disrupt the convenience for everyone. Please be patient and recognize Lewiston City is aware of the popularity of the service and is working

hard to keep the bins serviced and available for public use.
