Debra Wright who has been serving as a member of the Lewiston City Council has announced that she is moving out of Lewiston and will no longer be able to serve as a member of the City Council. We thank Debra for her service and wish her the best in her pursuits.

We are seeking candidates that would be willing to serve as a member of the Lewiston City Council for the remainder of 2021. Debra's original term was to serve through 2023 but Utah Code 20A-1-510 requires holding a special election in November 2021 to fill the two-year period after the current year. This is a great opportunity to learn and to serve our city. The replacement will be selected by City Council after interviews of the candidates at a date to be set by the Council. If you are interested in serving please submit a notice of interest with the City Clerk.

Since I started on the topic of elections it seems appropriate to also announce that there will be municipal elections this year for the office of mayor and two council members. Each of these positions carries a term of four years. Again, these are great opportunities to serve the community. The filing period for these positions will be June 1-7, 2021.

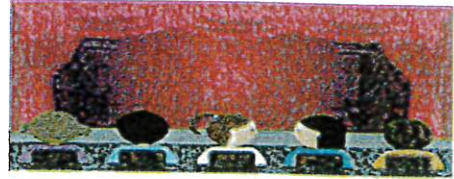
The engineering work on both our water and sewer projects is progressing as planned. A test well was drilled at the Cub River Recreation Complex which identified a viable location for the new well. Each of these projects should get underway in the coming construction season. The need for an alternate water source has become readily apparent as the current drought has severely affected the flow of our High Creek Spring. This is a new phenomenon that has not been identified in past periods of drought and could have a serious impact on our water supply without the planned additional resources.

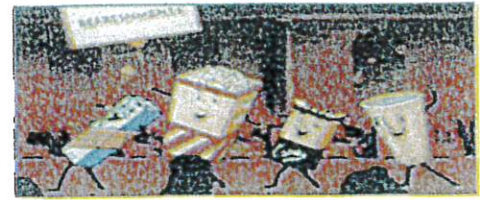

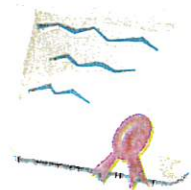
