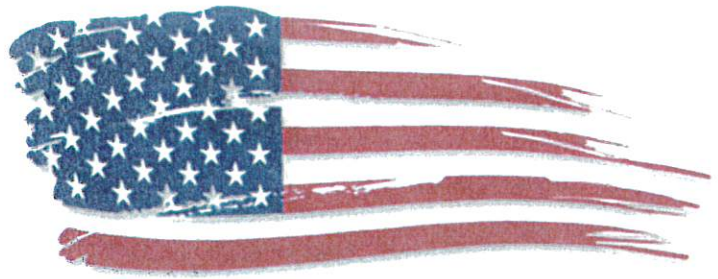


LEWISTON CITY July NEWSLETTER 2021



Mayor's Report

It felt good to return to our traditional July 4th celebration after the events of the past year. Many were able to participate in the activities during the day and to witness the spectacular firework display to cap the day off. The rodeo and the horse pulls both put on great shows and had large crowds. The breakfast, fun run, parade, booths, and other events were all successful and supported. This event would not be possible without the help of the many volunteers, sponsors, and hard work of the city employees. Thank you to all for your contribution and dedication.

Utah continues to experience severe drought conditions. Currently, Lewiston City has water to support our need. However, we do not have a large water storage capacity and must depend upon our sources to fill our roughly 1.5-million-gallon reservoir system. High demand by the users makes it difficult for the available flows to accomplish this need. As I travel around the city, I still see many watering landscapes during the hottest portion of the day. This places undue stress on our system. If we are to avoid mandatory water restrictions to allow downtime for our system to maintain required levels in the reservoirs water use must be reduced voluntarily. During the hours of 10 am through preferably 7 pm, reserve water uses for in home need and to supply drinking water for animals. Watering landscapes during the heat of the day is inefficient and much of the water evaporates before it can provide much benefit anyway. This action will also help you in the pocketbook as fees for water did increase on July 1 and will be reflected in the next billing.

The drought is not the reason for the rate increase. The rate increase is to support necessary repairs and upgrades to our water system. Both the water and sewer projects are moving forward. The sewer project

is currently out for bid and a contractor for the project will be chosen after a review of the bids. The well portion of the water project has been through the bid process and a successful bid has been received. This project will move forward this year and the completion of the well and associated reservoir will provide a true second source of culinary water to the city and will help with future situations such as we are currently experiencing.

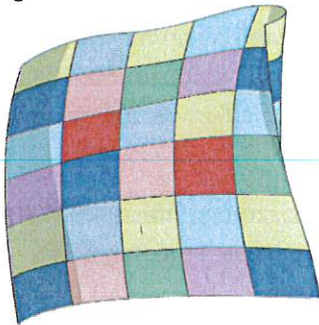
