MAYOR'S REPORT

MARCH 2019

There are several topics I would like to discuss in this month's newsletter, so I apologize in advance if the message wanders. Can you believe that it is already March? Winter will soon be leaving us, and the renewal of spring will be upon us. This winter was on the snowy and wet side so fields and drains will be full of water. In a big flat city with a high-water table like that of Lewiston it is difficult to predict and control where all the water will go. At this point we do not anticipate any major issues with runoff, but Mother Nature can change in a hurry. Please be cautious. As spring makes its appearance the debris of winter will be uncovered. I encourage all to take pride in our community and to clean and reinvigorate our properties and public places. As always as soon as possible the City will provide the large roll-off dumpster and green waste disposal bin to support this goal.

In 2019 there will be three City Council positions open for election. Our city needs creative and active participants in

the process to function properly. If you have a desire to serve your community and to learn and participate in the challenges of operating a small city, I encourage you to run for one of these positions. The filing period for the election will be June 3 through June 7, 2019.

Last month I discussed some much-needed improvements to our culinary water system. At this time, I would like to add some detail to the proposed improvements. The goal of the improvements is to ensure adequate water supply and flow to all parts of the city to meet current and future need and to provide adequate water for fire protection. The projects that we propose to seek immediate funding are as follow:


- Make sure all current water rights are correctly filed and secured
- Drill new well to access water from the Clear Creek Water source
- Improve sampling and analysis at the Hy Bair Spring

- Repair or replace current 400,000-gallon reservoir. If the current reservoir can be repaired, then a secondary reservoir at the
- Clear Creek site could be constructed to add storage capacity
- Replace 4" steel supply line along 2400 West with 12" PVC
- Replace 6" PVC supply line along 2400 West with 12" PVC
- Add new 8" PVC supply line along west 1600 South
- Replace 2.5" steel supply line along 2400 west with 8" PVC
- Replace 10" steel supply line along East 800 south with 10" PVC

As mentioned last month the cost of these improvements is significant, but they are required to update our culinary water system to adequately provide water to our large service area.
