Mayor's Report

Summer has passed us by and we are well into the autumn months. This summer was particularly dry but we had sufficient water resources to get through it. Hopefully the winter will be kind to us and we can rebuild the aquifers that supply our water needs. Please be mindful of the water situation and conserve where possible. We do not desire to restrict access to water but if the dry trend continues there may be no other options.

We live in a beautiful valley and community but it requires a continual effort to maintain. Fall is a great time to clean up our properties to prepare for the winter months. Lewiston City provides both a green waste and general trash waste facility for your use. Please take some time this fall to declutter your properties and help keep our city tidy and inviting. If you need help cleaning up your properties please speak up as there are groups available to assist with your needs.

Finally, to provide an update on several pro-

jects ongoing in our community. The road improvement project on 1600 West is complete except for a final seal. Because of availability issues with the seal coat product the final seal may not be completed until next year. The large project to stabilize the dike at the sewage lagoons is complete. Although this project is out of view of most citizens it was a major reconstruction project that required major work in and around the Cub River. This project will provide stability to the sewage lagoons for the long-term. UDOT is completing a project to replace a drainage culvert on east Center Street near the cemetery. The old culvert had rusted out and was replaced with a new plastic culvert.

Engineering work is still under way on Master Plans for both the water and sewer systems. These plans will identify upgrades and maintenance projects required to keep our systems viable.
