## Mayor's Report

By the time you read this another successful July 4<sup>th</sup> celebration will have passed. This yearly event is a great celebration of our country and the freedoms we enjoy. This event also brings many visitors to our community and provides us an opportunity to share a little that Lewiston has to offer. As the Mayor I thank all of the volunteers for their talents and hard work which makes this day possible.

There is one subject involving the celebration that causes me, the council and employees a great deal of grief each and every year. That subject is parade space reservation and parking. There appears to be two distinct and separate opinions regarding this subject. One being that an individual has a right to park any vehicle, trailer along the road to reserve space for an uncontrolled and unlimited amount of time. The other position being that parking or reserving space along the parade route is unfair and should not be permitted. As a council we have tried to deal with this situation by restricting overnight parking until

July 3<sup>rd</sup> as a compromise to allow the tradition to continue with a minimal impact. It has been our observation that a complete ban on parking is not the general public desire. We would welcome any input that could better help address this situation and I personally invite anyone with a solution to attend a council meeting with your ideas. The only request I make is that you are willing to identify yourself and that you are willing to openly discuss solutions knowing that there are other equally valid opinions that could be opposite of yours. This means the only real solution to the July 4<sup>th</sup> parking issue is a compromise.

This has been an unusual year for weather. The spring was very wet and now the summer has turned hot and dry. Although we should have ample water to meet our needs please use this resource wisely. Avoid watering during the heat of the day if possible. Watering during this time is not very efficient as the water evaporates before it can provide the desired result.
